Northwood Appold Community Academy (NACA) located at 4417 Loch Raven Boulevard opens its doors to all students in the Baltimore community for a summer of learning and fun. Located at the corner of Cold Spring Lane & Loch Raven Blvd, the Summer Academic Enrichment Program (AEP) will be in session from June 30 until August 1, 2008. The AEP runs from 9am -3pm and includes daily instruction in math, reading and writing.

Students have the advantage of working in a small classroom setting where the ratio is 15:2. Each group has a certified teacher and teachers assistant. For the cost of \$500 students are provided with healthy snacks and lunch, before and after care services as well as field trips. The end date for registration is June 12, 2008.
