**Monday, June 18, 2012 will be the last day of school for students and teachers if five inclement weather days are used to close schools due to weather-related emergencies during 2011-2012.** However, if there is no need to close schools due to weather-related emergencies the last day of school will be **Monday, June 11, 2012.**

If inclement weather conditions force the closing of schools for more than five days, it will be necessary to alter the school calendar. **Teacher days, however will not exceed 190. Student days will not exceed 180.** The Board of School Commissioners reserves the right to amend the 2011-2012 school calendar based upon the needs of the Baltimore City Public Schools.
